BRUSH AND LEAF PICKUP

The Department of Public Works, are now picking up brush, grass clippings, and yard waste starting the 1st week of the month. Brush must not exceed 4 inch diameter and be stacked in the boulevard, between the street and sidewalk. Leaves also must be piled in the boulevard, separate from yard waste. The city will not haul brush from tree removal. Please do not bag the yard waste or leaves. Anyone putting grass clippings, brush or leaves in the street will be subject to fines.

The 2014 Election Dates are as follows:

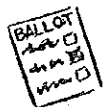
August 5, 2014 (Primary) Local proposals include:

- Reed City Area District Library Operations millage of 0.95 mill to support the daily operations of the Reed City Area District Library.
- Reed City Area District Library Bond proposal to borrow up to \$958,000 and issue bonds to finance the renovation and equipping of the future Library building located at 829 S. Chestnut.
- Osceola County Emergency Medical Services operation millage up to 1.33 mills for a period of six (6) years.
- Osceola County Commission on Aging millage up to 0.8 mill for a period of six (6) years.
- Renewal of Osceola County 9-1-1 Surcharge for emergency telephone call answering and dispatch services within Osceola County including facilities, equipment and operations.

November 4, 2014 (General) Local election of:

- Four (4) councilpersons.

You must be registered no later than 30 days prior to an election. You can register at the Secretary Of State or your local Clerk's Office. Residents of the City vote at the Fire Station, 523 Morse Street.

City Updates 2007 Water System Reliability Study

As part of being responsible to serve over 1,100 customers with 18 miles of underground piping delivering over 15 million gallons of water per month from 4 wells, the City must satisfy the State of Michigan that our system is reliable.

The City is in the midst of updating our 2007 Reliability Study and the results of that study will be published on-line in the City's expanded web site at www.reedcity.org.

The City currently charges \$2.00 per thousand gallons of metered water in addition to the sewer charges based on water usage.

Please remember a running toilet can use up to 1,400 gallons a day that would cost an extra \$283.50 on the monthly utility bill.

Application for Deferment of 2014 Summer Taxes



Application Deadline for filing with City Treasurer: September 14, 2014

There are two ways to be eligible for Deferment of your summer tax:

- the property must be your principal residence and your gross household income for the preceding calendar year cannot exceed \$40,000, and you qualify as one of the following:
 - 62 years of age or older
 - paraplegic, hemiplegic, or quadriplegic
 - eligible serviceperson, veteran, or eligible widow/widower
 - blind
 - totally & permanently disabled
- your property qualifies as agricultural real property

Once the application is filed with the City Treasurer, you have until the following February 14 to pay your summer property taxes without penalties or interest.
