Sesquicentennial: Dawn Montague gave an update on the final steps happening with the Sesquicentennial Celebration committee. It is coming together nicely; they are looking for volunteers to help with various events.

Pocket Park: Motion by Guiles, seconded by Meinert, **CARRIED**, to approve the plans for the Chestnut Street Pocket Park, 207 Old 131 (NW-X of W. Slosson Ave. and N. Chestnut St.) and designate said area as City Park. Affirmed by voice vote.

City Manager report:

City Manager Rich Saladin reported that the Pocket Park Project is underway, with Gerber expected to complete by December 2025. Corrina Hervey received a Grant from MEDC to assist with rehabilitation at the 101 W. Upton Building. City is underway with the new financial system to BS&A. Roth St water main replacement is complete. Franklin and Sears water main replacement will begin after the 4th of July.
