SPECIAL COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
June 10, 2019

Mayor Trevor Guiles, called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M. in Council Chambers, 227 East Lincoln Avenue, Reed City, Michigan with the pledge to the flag.

Present Mayor, Trevor Guiles. Council Members: Nate Bailey, Dan Burchett, Karen Lea McKinney, Dave Scharlow and Carol Tillotson. Roger Meinert was absent. City Manager, Ron Howell and Police Chief Chuck Davis were also present. There were citizens in the audience.

Street closure There was discussion on closure of a portion of Higbee Street, location and size of fencing to be used, size and location of tent, serving of liquor and direction of live music for an outdoor anniversary celebration.

Motion by Bailey, seconded by Scharlow, **CARRIED**, to allow Reed City Brewing (based on discussion) to close down the section of Higbee Street identified in the Option 1 drawing as presented, for Saturday, June 29th from 9:00 A.M. until 10:00 A.M., Sunday, June 30th, for an outdoor anniversary celebration of being in business for two years. Roll call vote. Voting yes were, Tillotson, Scharlow, McKinney, Guiles, Bailey and Burchett.

MSHDA Motion by Bailey, seconded by Burchett, **CARRIED**, to authorize the City Manager to sign the MSHDA Grant Agreement if it comes in, and in the event the council is not able to convene in time, or there is a chance the City might lose the grant on the documents as presented. Roll call vote. Voting yes were, McKinney, Burchett, Bailey, Guiles, Scharlow and Tillotson.

Closed Door Motion by McKinney, seconded by Bailey, **CARRIED**, to enter into closed door session for the purpose of union negotiation strategy. Roll call vote. Voting yes were, Bailey, Scharlow, McKinney, Tillotson, Burchett and Guiles.

Council went into closed session at 7:31 P.M.

Council returned to open session at 7:42 P.M.

No decisions were made in closed session.
