Summer Property Tax Due Date September 2nd

Property Taxes are payable beginning July 1, 2025. The last day to pay without penalty is Tuesday, September 2, 2025. A 4% administration fee will be assessed Wednesday, September 3, 2025 and interest of ½% per month will be added beginning October 1, 2025. Taxes can be paid from 8:00am to 5:00pm Mon.-Fri. at 227 E. Lincoln, Reed City, Ml. 49677, or online at reedcity.org (fees apply).

Brush and Leaf Pickup

The Department of Public Works will be picking up brush, grass clippings and leaves after the snow melts on the 1st Monday of each month until November. The following are some guidelines for pick up.

*All MUST be separated. ie: Different piles for brush, grass clippings and leaves

*Brush must not exceed 4 inch diameter

*Must be stacked in the boulevard (between the street & sidewalk)

*Leaves also must be piled in boulevard (separate from brush and grass)

*Please DO NOT bag leaves, grass or brush
*NO brush from tree removal
*NO animal waste.

If these guidelines are not followed your brush & leaves will NOT be picked up and are subject to fines.



Accountability and Transparency

In order for each city/village/township/county to receive State Revenue Sharing Incentive Program payments, they need to produce and make available to the public, a Citizen's Guide, Performance Dashboard, Debt Service Report, and a Projected Budget Report.
